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Quran o Seera course: Main aspects of the course


- Arabic text of the Surahs mostly recited in the prayer and the text of the prayer
- Simple Arabic Grammar- using interactive teaching Methods: (TPI)
- Seerah aspects- it actually requires separate exclusive sessions but we will briefly discuss different aspects of Seerah at the end of the sessions.
- Why ? The blessed Rasool is the first assignee and addressee of the guidance of Allah
- He is the role model for us

The followings can be considered as the main objectives of the course

Objectives of the Course (20 hours)

- 1. To convince you that the Qur'an is easy to understand
- To teach you how to start understanding the Qur'an the easy way, using word-for-word study and TPI and teach 50% words of the Qur'an!
- 3. To help you pray Salah effectively with Khusoo, i.e, humility (by teaching you 7 Surahs and Azkar of Salah)
- 4. To teach you how to bring the Qur'an into our lives
- 5. To teach basic Arabic Grammar using a simple system called TPI
- 6. To teach 100 sentences of (Qur'an centric) Spoken Arabic

(You will see this in grammar sessions)



Easy to Learn!

So the suggestion that "Al-Qur'an is difficult" is from shaitan! Even in your thoughts, <u>NEVER agree</u> with it and <u>NEVER say</u> it.

If you learn... The meaning of every word from a typical Salah!

Along with extremely simple Grammar using TPI.. then you learn 232 words that occur 41,000 * times or 50%! or half the words in every line!

> i.e., every 2nd word of the Qur'an is from Salah!



*39,000 times, to be more correct; still that makes 50% of the Qur'anic words.

What is the outcome of the course

- Making the Quran relevant to our lives
- Using our obligatory prayers as a mean to improve our lively relationship with God and improving Khushu' (humbleness)
- The Satan attacks us using different techniques and divert our attention by injecting Waswasa (evil/ vain thoughts) and diverting our attention during the prayer



How to achieve the objectives mentioned above ?

By guarding all of our brain's channels - Example of driving

We can work on 5 things at time: 5 channels of our brain

Example: when you drive, you:

- Control the steering
- Control the breaks
- Talk to you friend
- Watch the road
- Look for your shop ...

While praying, keep all the channels busy

- Recite
- with tajweed
- Understand what you recite
- Visualize what you recite
- Feel it & interact with it

USE TPI !!! Use all your senses

- 1. Hear it
- 2. See it
- 3. Think it
- 4. Say it
- 5. Show it
- 6. Love it
- 7. Do it together

Can you repeat it with me; with actions!

Waswasa and prophetic approach

Waswasah

One of the Sahabah complained to the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) about waswas during prayer, and he said: "The Shaytan comes between me and my prayers and my recitation, confusing me therein."

The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: "That is a devil called Khanzab. If he affects you, seek refuge in Allah from him and spit dryly to your left three times."

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the solution to Waswasah

He (the Sahabi) said, I did that and Allah took him away from me. (Narrated by Muslim, 2203)

 We should apply this hadith but before reciting this practice, let us close the doors and windows of our house to block the thief entering the house. What are these doors and windows or the channels of the brain?

We should recite

اَعُوْذُ بِاللهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطنِ الرَّجِيمِ

before reciting Surah Fatihah or Qur'an.

Let us study that first.

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
